The IACRC Meeting was conducted for Sundargarh District at Govt. (Auto) College, Rourkela, on 18.01.2024 in pursuance of the Govt. Order No.546/HE., Dtd. 05.01.2024 under the Chairmanship of F.A.-cum-Special Secretary to Govt. in Higher Education Department. In the said meeting the Principal, Govt. (Auto) College, Rourkela, representatives of other Institutions, IAO-cum- Under Secretary to Govt., Audit Officer, Auditor of Higher Education Department were present.

At the outset of the meeting the Principal, Govt. (Auto) College, Rourkela welcomed all the participants. The importance of conducting IACRC Meeting was elaborately explained by the F.A.-cum-Special Secretary to Govt., Higher Education Department.

Sub: Release of fund towards non civil activity under Odisha Higher Education Program for Excellence and Equity (OHEPEE)

Madam / Sir,

I would like to congratulate you on the signing of MoU and subsequently finalizing the list of activities to be carried out for your college under this program. It has been decided that in 37 nos. of colleges in urban areas, the civil work will be executed by the Works department and in 31 nos. of colleges in rural areas, work will be executed by the Rural Development department (copy enclosed).

For non-civil activities, as per discussions with you, the department is releasing the first year fund to the colleges totaling Rs. 15.46 crores (Rs. 3,74,48,000 for 12 no. of Govt colleges and Rs. 11,71,61,000 for 56 no. of Aided colleges) as per Annexure-I. The colleges are required to comply with the following guidelines for proper utilization of the fund:

- 1. The fund is being released into the bank account of the college for implementing the activities. Diversion of the fund released to other schemes is prohibited.
- 2. All the procurement of the goods and services made by utilizing the program fund shall comply with para 2.2 of Finance and Procurement Manual issued.
- 3. A separate scheme register is to be maintained. All the purchases and construction made under this project are to be entered in this register.
- 4. All the aided colleges receiving funds under this scheme are required to update the online accounting module CAPA on all financial receipts and expenditures w.e.f 1.4.2019. This is for funds under this program as well as other receipts and expenditures

under various heads. The backlog entry at any point of time should be less to days.

- 5. The colleges are allowed to take up the following expenditures under the non-civil fureleased:
  - a) Purchase of furniture as per the EPM rate contract (Cot, Desk, Bench, Chair, Table etc.). Clarification issued on the EPM rate contract vide letter no. 619/dated 18.7.2019 is enclosed for reference.
  - b) Purchase of computers by following the proper method as per the procurement manual.
  - c) Purchaser of water purifiers and fire extinguishers.
  - d) Money can be utilized for EHS (Environment, Health and Safety) aspect for which instructions will be given from time to time.
  - e) Purchase of library books (CBCS text and reference books) and lab. Equipments.
  - f) Training of the teaching and non teaching staff. In case of trainings at the college level, prior permission from the PD is required. Approval of such trainings needs to be routed through the Sr. Consultant (Capacity Building) via email communication at <a href="mailto:saritaatu@gmail.com">saritaatu@gmail.com</a>
    - Training /workshop plan
    - Expenditure on Training/Workshops
  - g) For research proposal and other quality and equity enhancement related training programs, specific permission to be obtained from SPD by giving email to the nodal officer concerned. A brief of the activity and associated cost has to be mentioned for approval.

6. The colleges receiving the fund are required to complete the audit before 30<sup>th</sup> September for each financial year

The Colleges are required to finalize the master plan of the college and drawings of the buildings to be constructed under this program in consultation with the Architecture Consultant engaged by the PWD / RD department.

Subsequent year fund release will be based on satisfactory achievement of following conditions:

a) Submission of 60% Utilization Certificate of the fund released.

- b) On Time Graduation (OTG): 3% increase in OTG from base line year (2017-18) overall and each of the categories of General/SC/ST/Women.
- c) Improvement in NAAC grading (for applicable colleges)
- d) Declaration of the composition of their Governing Bodies on the website. Holding Governing Body (GB) meeting 4 times in a year and uploading the proceedings in college website in 15 days. Further all the proceeding of the G B meeting from April 2019 is required to be uploaded in the college website by 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2019.
- e) Data entry in CAPA with backlog less than 30 days (all aided colleges)
- f) Completing tenders on time and issuing work order within validity of bid. Validity of bids refers to the number of days the bid remains valid from the date of opening of the tender. Whenever a tender is floated, Validity of bid should be mentioned for reasonable price quotations. The allowed time period for validity of bid are:
